Use your top ideas for controlling your **carbon footprint** and create a presentation to explain what you would do and why other people should get involved too.

What is a presentation?

A presentation is a talk where one person or a group share information or ideas with an audience. Sometimes this is called '**a pitch**'.

They often use computers to create slides, which might show words, phrases, pictures or even video clips. The slides are designed to share the information in an attractive and meaningful way.

'**a pitch**' is when you share information and ideas with other people, so that you can persuade them to think more like you do.

Use the story board slide to help you prepare your presentation

Design tips on making your presentation slides

■ Use bullet points to break up your information – only use 5-6 bullet points on each slide.

■ Use pictures to add interest. You may be able to use photos you have taken yourself with a digital camera.

■ Keep it focused – use no more than 35 words on each slide.

■ Keep the slide clear, stick to one or two colours or fonts.

Presentation tips on sharing your presentation with others

- Give the audience time to read your slides
- Be yourself!
- Finish on time

- Go slowly!
- Look at your audience and ask them questions to keep them interested.
